ZCAS Computer Lab General Rules

1. Access & Authorization

- Only registered students, faculty, and authorised personnel may use the lab.
- Users must log in using their assigned ZCAS Login credentials.

2. Lab Hours & Usage

- The lab is open during designated hours only **(08:00 – 17:00)**. ***Due to computer-based examinations conducted on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays, the labs are usually closed from 08:00 to 14:00 to facilitate the smooth running of exams. Please be sure to read the white notice board before entering the computer lab.***

3. Food & Drinks

- No food or drinks are allowed near computers to prevent damage.

4. Noise & Disturbances

- Maintain a **quiet environment**; silence mobile phones and avoid loud conversations.
- Use headphones for audio to avoid disturbing others.

5. Respect Lab Equipment

- Do not tamper with, modify, or unplug hardware.
- Report any technical issues or malfunctions to the IT staff.

6. No Unauthorized Software

- Do not install, modify, or delete any software without permission.
- Use only pre-installed programs for coursework.

7. Internet Usage

- Access only **educational and research-related websites**.
- Avoid visiting inappropriate or restricted websites.

8. Printing Guidelines

- Printing is not allowed for students. Plan to print outside ZCAS for any academic work.

9. Save Work Properly

- Save files on **personal cloud storage or external drives** (institution computers may delete files after logging out).
- Do not store personal data on lab computers.

10. Log Out After Use

- Always log out of personal accounts before leaving.

11. Furniture

- After using a workstation, kindly push your chair back into place to maintain an organized and safe environment for the next user.

11. No Cybersecurity Violations

- Do not attempt hacking, phishing, or bypassing security settings.
- Respect **ZCAS IT policies** regarding internet security and data privacy.

12. No Unauthorized Sharing

- Do not share your ZCAS login credentials with others.

13. No Gaming or Streaming

- Gaming and non-academic video streaming are prohibited.

14. Adhere to Institution Policies

- Follow all institution IT and academic integrity policies.

15. Respect Others

- Do not occupy a station longer than necessary if others are waiting.
- Keep the lab clean and return chairs to their proper positions.
